The following week Rosie <u>officially graduated from language school</u>, and we began moving out of our house. Since we are going to be moving to another city, our belongings in Japan are currently in temporary storage until we have returned and found a house in Nagaoka.

On March 14<sup>th</sup>, the <u>Hill family had a farewell party for us</u> at the church. The following day, we boarded an airplane to the United States and landed in Atlanta. After staying with Rosie's parents for several days we moved into an apartment that we rented near Vision Baptist Church (about 10 minutes away). It was our first time traveling internationally with both kids, so it definitely had some unforeseen challenges. However, we are glad to be <u>over jet lag</u> and getting a more normal day-to-day rhythm.
