We are currently looking for 3 guys to come to Japan on a ministry internship for the summer of 2023.

During this three-month internship, you and two other guys will be responsible for spending time at a local basketball court to make friendships and help connect young guys to a new church plant in addition to helping with other minor ministry activities.

Japanese language skills are not required to apply but language learning will be included in the internship.

Objectives

- Experiencing Cross cultural ministry
- Making friends through basketball to share the Gospel
- Learning to share the Gospel with people who have no Christian context
