We will need to pay to have some work done so it will be suitable for us to use, and we are currently waiting to get an estimate back on how much the renovations will cost. Please keep praying!

Along with having adequate space for people to be able to come, we are also working to prepare people so the church plant can be in a position to accommodate guests better. To do this, we held a **volunteer meeting**, explaining the importance of thinking about what we do from the perspective of someone who has never been to church before and remove as many barriers as possible to people believing the Gospel. We will need to find a meeting space for this ministry, as the location we had planned to use fell through, and also to find language tutors for the interns during their term here.
